Parent expectation:

As a result, parents are expected to be present on campus and provide assistance while their children are in class, and parents are expected to volunteer for tasks such as event planning, field trip coordination, or classroom assistance.

Classes

With the exception of high school core subjects, classes change from semester to semester.

Classes for elementary school students are usually free to members and do not require homework. However, core high school courses have a fee and require homework.
